

Community Support Services

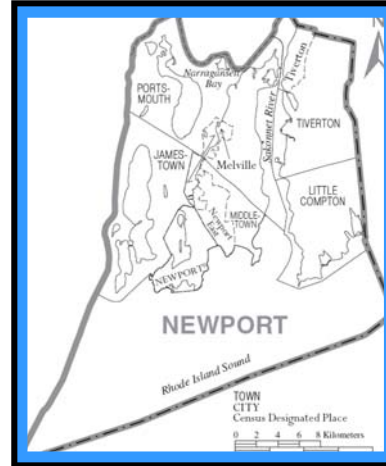
Community Support Services provide a comprehensive array of care for adults with serious and persistent mental illness, especially those at risk for hospitalization, homelessness, involvement with the criminal justice system, ongoing substance abuse or unemployment. Individual case management and multidisciplinary team oriented case management services are provided to clients. These services are intended to promote recovery and do adhere to Rhode Island's Level of Care Model for services.

Outpatient & Emergency Services

Emergency services is a 24 hour per day, 7 day per week service for persons who may need short-term, time-limited services including: clinical assessment face to face, telephone clinical screening, triage, crisis stabilization, brief treatment, crisis case management, emergency evaluation for hospitalization and psychiatric assessment. Services are provided by psychiatrists, clinical nurse specialists, registered nurses, licensed clinicians and case managers.

Outpatient Services are designed to treat persons who are suffering significant psychological stress and symptoms in their lives. Staff work with individuals and/or families to help with a variety of problems including anxiety, depression, obsessions and compulsions, and post-traumatic stress disorder. Additionally, our **Substance Abuse Program** treats adults who have chemical abuse or dependence problems and specializes in care for individuals with co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders.

Children Intensive Services is a community-based program of mental health services for children ages 2 – 18 who meet any of the following criteria: severe emotional or behavioral struggles, at serious risk for hospitalization, at risk of out-of-home placement, or faced with juvenile justice issues.

Children Intensive Services offers an array of therapeutic,

clinical, services which include 24 hour crisis assessment/intervention, crisis stabilization, psychiatric/medication evaluation, family assessment or re-assessment, and development of individualized treatment plans. Intensive therapeutic treatment may include medication management, individual, family and group therapy, and therapeutic case management.
